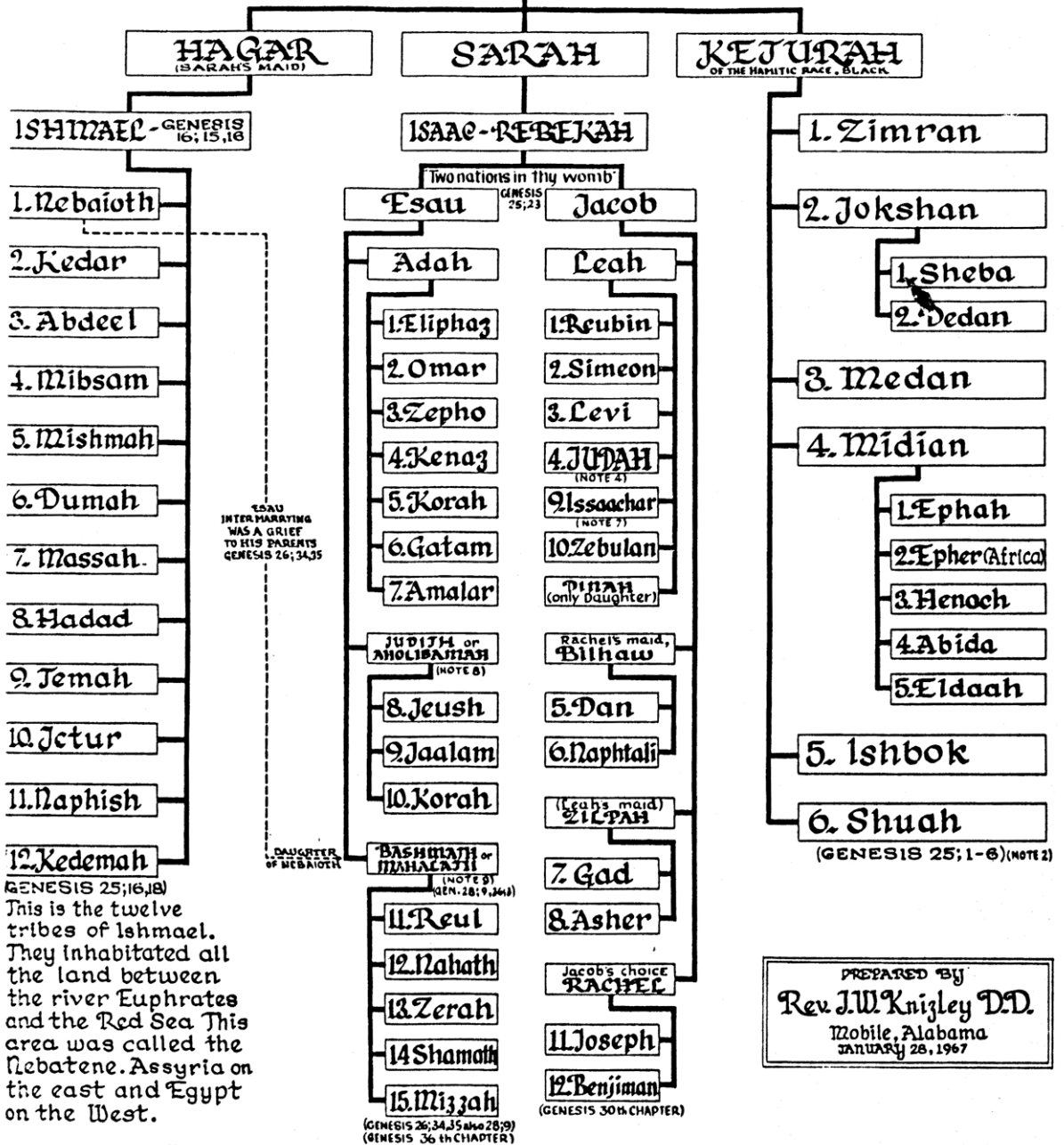


# ABRAHAM

1. Job was grandson to Jacob through Issaachar.
2. Job's three friends;
  1. Eliphaz was the oldest son of Esau by Adah.
  2. Bildad was a descendent of Shuah, by Keturah.
  3. Zophar a Syrian, descendent of Captain Naaman. Which is Job's distant relative through the family tree, and great grandmother Rebekah, the Syrian.
3. By pre-arrangement the three friends came from their respective places for the occasion to sit with their wealthy friend Job, to offer their sympathy, advice and criticism. The latter was the greatest.
4. JUDAH 4th. son of Jacob-Leah
  1. Er (the Lord slew him)
  2. Onan (the Lord slew him also)
  3. Shelah (by Caanitish woman)
  4. Pharez } twin brothers by Tamar
  5. Zerah }

5. Judah's wife was a descendent of Caanan, son of Ham (Gen. 10; 6) She bare the first three sons.
6. The twins (Pharez and Zerah) were born to Judah by his daughter-in-law, Tamar, wife of Er and Onan.
7. To Issaachar was born four sons:
  1. Tola
  2. Phuvah
  3. Job (or Jashub) 1.Chron. 7; 1
  4. Shimron
 (Genesis 46; 13) (Numbers 26; 23-25)
8. Judith means; "praised Jewess" physical features like that of the hated seed of Isaac, a trophy. Aholibamah, means temporary dwelling in the hills, or "tent in the hills".  
 The State of Alabama has for its meaning "Here we rest". This word came from the Indian word.
9. Bashmath means, "Pleasing". The name Mahalath means "Harp". Esau's 3rd., wife as a pleasing musician.
